Director's Corner

Summer break is over. It's back to the regularly scheduled parish, school, work and home.

Chapter Business. September kicks off our chapters' year. Time to renew membership or to become a member. Chapter Mass/Dinner. Sign up now for the Sept. 21 annual chapter Mass and dinner for either the DC or Arlington chapter. Even with the best of science or Holy Spirit infusion, it's doubtful you can attend both, so pick one and go. It's an absolutely fabulous evening to celebrate Mass and to enjoy food and fellowship. New Divine Worship. James Starke, new Director of Divine Worship for the Diocese of Arlington, will address participants at our Fall Liturgy Day gathering on Oct. 20 (see calendar of events on page 3). Starke's duties include chairing the newly formed diocesan liturgical commission. He also coordinates liturgies over which Arlington Bishop Michael Burbidge presides, such as confirmations, ordinations, dedications and other major events, according to the *Arlington Catholic Herald*. The newspaper also reports that Starke will serve as the bishop's master of ceremonies during liturgies and give talks on liturgy and the sacraments for the diocesan speakers bureau. Starke received the Master of Philosophy and Doctor

of Philosophy degrees in Liturgical Studies and Sacramental Theology from the Catholic University of America. He and his family are members of Arlington's Our Lady of Lourdes parish.

NPM Staff Changes. NPM President **Steve Petrunak** announced, effective Sept. 1, **Berta Sabrio** joins as the national organization as Vice President of Programming and Planning. The 35-year NPM member co-chaired this year's Baltimore convention and is past director of the Baltimore chapter. She is on the Cantor Steering Committee and holds several certificates in cantor development.

Along with Petrunak and Sabrio, **Kathleen Haley**, Director of Membership Services, and **Jill Stennmann**, Director of Publications and Development, round out NPM's full-time staff. Petrunak noted the organization will "continue to depend on a network of qualified contract workers

and dedicated volunteers who provide support with staff oversight." He thanked departing staffers **Peter Maher** and **Paul Lajoy** "for their long and dedicated service" to NPM and its members. Maher was Chief Operating Officer and Director of Conventions and Institutes in recent years, and Lajoy was Secretary and Mail Clerk. The restructuring "will position NPM to fervently serve its members and mission into an exciting and challenging future," Petrunak wrote.

NPM's Inaugural Summer Institute for Youth and Advocates

Our young people in music ministry have busy summers. While my students in grades 3-12 are on summer break, I offer a college cantor program for auditioned students who are home for the summer, to earn a modest stipend while receiving training, attending rehearsals, and scheduling cantor times for Mass.

Through the years, you know who these high school and college students are: the ones that are present and engaged, who love the music and our Lord. You likely have had some of them since grade school. Young Catholic students such as these, from sophomores in high school to sophomores in college from all over the U.S., came with open hearts and inquisitive minds to *One Call* summer institute at St. John's University in Collegeville, MN for six days this past June. I was very fortunate to attend as well.

One Call is NPM's newest venture: "dedicated to the engagement, empowerment, and ongoing support of young liturgical musicians... to maximize their gifts of music and leadership in service to the liturgy... (and help them) to grow musically, theological, spiritually, and communally."

If we could afford to spend the time and resources to grow our own personal and professional knowledge as advocates for these young people, and at the same time, give these students the very

best that NPM has to offer, what would that look like?

I urge you to check out the website: onecallinstitute.org and related social media. Explore the St. John's Abbey and University campus, read about team leaders, musicians, and educators, review

the programming for students and for (adult) advocates. I discovered that every detail of these programs was finely honed, and well situated. From the financial support of industry sponsors, to the college's most gracious welcome, this institute is truly an extraordinary opportunity for our older music ministry

students, and for us (including clergy, liturgists, musicians, and youth ministry leaders).

One major takeaway: What happens when your students return to your parish or college

after this intensive institute is just as much at the heart of what NPM is trying to accomplish as offering you and your students a very impactful, educational, prayerful, musical and community-building week.

The Boards of your local chapters hope this avenue of advertising for your ministry and parish events will help grow your programs and community involvement.

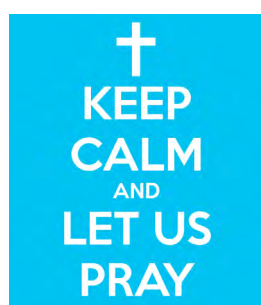

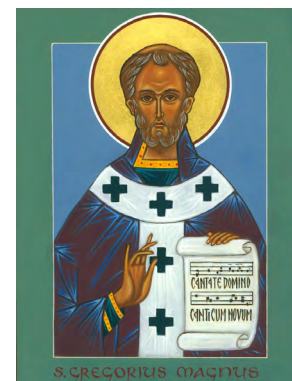
